## ADDITIONAL REMINDERS FOR COLLEGE BOXERS

Uniform Rule:	No binding material (Such as tape) permitted on the sleeveless shirt
	nor shorts. Waistband of shorts must be a different color than the
	sleeveless shirt. Shorts may not extend past top of knee.
Protectors:	Men boxers are required to wear a groin protector. Protectors are
	optional for women boxers.
Weigh-In & Physicals:	All boxers weigh on the first day of the tournament, otherwise boxers
	weigh in only on the days in which they are scheduled to compete.
Hair:	Hair must be contained beneath the headgear. Boxers with long hair
	must wear a cap or net.
Facial Hair:	No beards below shoulder length.
Piercings:	All jewelry, including earrings, nose rings, tongue rings, etc., must be
	removed prior to entering the ring.
